These duties include night cover, ward duty, trauma cover (including a trauma clinic and theatre), consultant clinics, MOS sessions, day surgery and in patient operating lists. • Countess of Chester On-Call/Out of Hours is 1 in 5 rota covering A&E and the ward is from 8am until 10pm. Outside these hours the “Hospital At Night” team and the Regional Maxillofacial Unit on-call team provide care.
