Royal Bolton Hospital Emergency Department

The Emergency Department at the Royal Bolton Hospital sees approximately 115,000 patients a year including over 25,000 children who attend our dedicated Paediatric Emergency Department.

We have 11 Consultants working alongside a robust Middle Grade team as well as ANP's, Emergency Physiotherapists and an Emergency Pharmacist.

We have a reputation for being a friendly coherent group of Consultants with a strong educational ethos, within the Department, we have 2 Educational Clinical Fellows with dedicated time to support Education within the Emergency Department.

We have good relations with all Specialties, in particular we work closely with the Acute Medicine and Intensive Care teams and we are developing our already strong links with Paediatrics.

We are a Major Trauma Unit and the Royal Bolton Hospital acts as a Regional Hospital for Maternity and Neonatology Services around Greater Manchester.

We are currently modernising our Department and have recently opened our new 6 bedded Resuscitation area, we are expanding our Minors area and have recently expanded our Majors Department.
