	8.30 am – 4.30 pm (30 mins for lunch) Trafford Community Dental Service is based within the Altrincham Health & Wellbeing Centre which is in the centre of the town. It is less than a five-minute walk from the Metrolink. Free parking is available in the nearby Stamford Quarter carpark. We have a brand new 3 surgery practice which is well equipped with rotary endo, an OPG machine, wheelchair tipper and bariatric dental chairs. We have a wide range of instruments and materials including bio dentine & SDF. There are 4 dentists in our team and a dental therapist. We are exceptionally well supported by our team leader, admin staff and highly qualified & experienced nurses, all of whom have post- qualifications such as radiography, sedation, oral health, fluoride varnish, health living dentistry. They also have a wealth of experience working with dental students and newly qualified dentists. The oral health team are based within our department in Altrincham and so are available to provide the team with advice when needed. Our service provides care for anyone unable to access dentistry within a general dental practice. Children and adults who have additional needs such as:Learning disabilityPhysical disabilityAutistic Spectrum Disorder Children who are dentally anxious Treatment is carried out within Trafford CDS with LA and under inhalation sedation. Within our trust, we also offer intravenous sedation for both anxious adults and special care patients and provide treatment under general anaesthetic for both adults and children. In addition, we offer domiciliary care and are part of the annual epidemiology programme. In the past DCTs within our trust have been involved in all these areas of the Community Dental Service.

I then decided to go into General dental practice in Manchester and worked in the same practice for seven years. During this tenure I attended the Paul Tipton course for restorative/cosmetic dentistry as that is my area of special interest. I am training to become an Invisalign provider at the moment and plan to introduce implant placement services over the next year. Our practice is a modern practice computerised (SOE) & with digital x-ray. The staff are really friendly. They have been at the practice for a long time - the receptionist for 45 years & Practice Manager for 38 years she joined the practice when she was 18! The nurses are all friendly and helpful. Since I took over the practice in 2014, I have renovated the whole practice with a new surgery & decontamination room. The FD will have a fairly new surgery. As I am interested in teaching, I have completed PG cert in teaching and learning. We are expanding the practice to include another surgery which will be completed by July.
