Description of the DCT training post	The post will involve provision of primary dental care to patient groups whose care cannot be met within general dental services. This will include ongoing care for children and adults with special needs and children who have been referred to the service for treatment using inhalation sedation or general anaesthetic. This will include working alongside Specialists in both Paediatric Dentistry and Special Care Dentistry and several other very experienced Community Dentists. IASCD accredited training in inhalation sedation will be provided.
	The post also offers opportunities for in-hospital theatre experience for the provision of care under general anaesthetic on occasion.
	The service also hosts training posts for other postgraduate dentists in training – Dental Core Training and Specialty Training in Paediatric Dentistry and Special Care Dentistry.
