We look forward to welcoming you to Chester and are moving into our fantastic new Women & Children's building in summer 2025 which will showcase modern facilities for all of our patients. The clinical teams have been heavily involved in the planning and design process from conception and we are excited to see our vision brought to life.

We provide consultant cover on our emergency gynaecology assessment unit over several sessions per week to provide emergency ambulatory procedures such as Word catheters for

Bartholin's abscess, MVA for surgical management of miscarriage and paracentesis for malignant ascites. The majority of our hysteroscopic procedures are also performed in an outpatient setting. We provide gynaecological surgical training in laparoscopic, open and vaginal hysterectomy and are a BSGE accredited endometriosis centre. We are an oncology unit with a weekly MDT meeting to discuss cases, feeding into the regional tertiary oncology service.

Our teaching programme runs weekly for resident doctors, supported by the fetal surveillance midwife and consultants for discussion of interesting CTG cases, interesting gynae cases, CBD and portfolio opportunities. We also have regular whole department audit and teaching update sessions that occur on various half days throughout the year when elective work is stood down to allow all, except the on call team, to attend.
