The practice is a large, modern six-surgery family practice with a fantastic reputation within our local community. We have been a training practice for over 25 years and have been a BDA Good Practice member for over 20 years. The clinicians currently working at the practice comprise of our two partners, five associate dentists, a hygienist, and our current foundation dentist. With such an approachable and large clinical team to learn from, there is a wealth of knowledge to be gained as a foundation dentist. We also have a supportive and friendly team of experienced dental nurses, receptionists, and our practice manager.

The practice offers a full range of both NHS and private treatments. You will have access to all materials and equipment, including an intraoral scanner, a DSLR camera, a sandblaster, an airflow handpiece, and rotary endodontic equipment.

Our practice is located just off junction 4 of the M58 motorway and is easily commutable from Liverpool and Manchester. There is free car parking at the practice and plenty of local shops and amenities.

Working hours for the foundation dentist are Monday, Wednesday and Thursday 8:45am-17:00pm and Tuesday 8:45am-18:45pm (patients are booked in from 9:00am). Most Fridays, when not a study day, will be time off in lieu for working until 18:45pm on Tuesdays.


