

## How to Avoid an Outcome 5

**An outcome 5 is not an adverse outcome**, it's a **holding outcome**, meaning you get a little extra time to update your portfolio, but we understand that it can be frustrating and disheartening to receive an Outcome 5. We've put together a quick checklist that will help you avoid getting an Outcome 5 in the future:

### ARCP Checklist:

- Please have everything uploaded **at least** a week before your ARCP panel, at the **latest** 2 days before your panel.
- Complete a full **Educational Supervisor's Report** (ESR) before the panel
- **Form R Part B**
  - Section 2: Ensure dates are formatted fully, e.g. 1/1/21
  - Ensure all TOOT days are filled in, especially in the total box!
    - Calculated as 1 week = 7 days, even if you're not on shift
    - Consistent with what you have on your E Portfolio
  - Ensure you've ticked or put an X next to all of the boxes in Section 3, 4, and 5
  - Signed and dated within 8 weeks of the panel
    - E.g. if your ARCP is on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2021, the window for this would be: Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2021 – Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2021
- **COVID-19 Self Declaration Form**
  - Signed and dated within 8 weeks of panel
  - Please note if COVID-19 has affected your training, especially if it's affected gaining some competencies
- **BLS/ALS Certificate** is up to date and uploaded
- **Adult Safe Guarding Certificate** is up to date and uploaded
- **Child Safe Guarding Certificate** is up to date and uploaded

### Tips:

- Upload your Form R using this method: <https://support.fourteenfish.com/hc/en-gb/articles/360016671257-Uploading-Form-R>
- Ensure everything is uploaded before your Educational Supervisor signs off your ESR to avoid technical issues.
- It takes 14Fish (your programme) **24 hours** to back up to FishBase (the programme we use)
- Even if you're on maternity leave, you will need to upload a Form R and COVID-19 Self Declaration Form, but you don't need an ESR.
