Guidance sets out minimum standards for employers and provides additional information to HR departments, IMGs and their ESs on the areas that need to be covered to provide effective induction and support to all IMGs employed and supported by them.

Guidance also sets out in detail what Trusts should provide in terms of welcome and pastoral induction, professional practice induction, IT and electronic patient record systems induction, and language & communication induction.

The guidance is supported by an extensive list of resources including elearning modules, exemplary checklists and other relevant documents from which IMGs, NHS employers and supervisors can select or supplement according to individual, speciality, and local needs.
