We have excellent road and rail transport links with Liverpool, Chester and the surrounding areas.</p> <p>The clinical equipment we have to offer includes rotary endodontic units, digital radiographs and an intraoral scanner. We have a dedicated decontamination room, a large waiting area and good staff facilities.</p> <p>We pride ourselves on being a well organised and welcoming practice to work in. Currently four dentists (including one FD) and two hygienists work on a part time basis to provide care to our patients. They are ably supported by a team of dental nurses and receptionists.
