### Unit Name and description

Liverpool Women's Hospital

The Liverpool Women's Hospital is a regional tertiary referral centre with approximately 8000 deliveries yearly. We are one of the only two Foundation Trusts in the UK dedicated to the healthcare of women and babies.

We provide tertiary specialist services for Maternal Medicine, Fetal Medicine, Preterm Birth, Gynaecological Oncology, Urogynaecology, Fertility, Menopause, Endometriosis, and Robotic Surgery.

We have approximately 7500 deliveries per year. As well as managing low risk women on the midwifery led unit, we see a large cohort of high risk patients due to the fetal medicine service and level 3 neonatal unit, which accepts premature gestations from 22 weeks and upwards. The unit is also a regional centre for the diagnosis and management of placenta accreta.

Liverpool is the regional gynaecology cancer centre and provides robotically-assisted laparoscopic surgery. LWH is also the base for the Hewitt Reproductive medicine unit and has a well established urogynaecology service and one of the largest colposcopy services in the country.

There are strong research links with the university of Liverpool with many consultants holding academic posts and multiple research projects currently running
