Programme Details	<p>This is a 3-year training programme in Core Psychiatry Training at CT1 aimed at doctors who can demonstrate the essential competences to enter this level of training. The programme is designed to support training for a CCT in a Higher Psychiatry specialty. Details of essential competences and qualifications are detailed in the national person specification for Core Psychiatry Training at CT1 which is available from <a href="http://specialtytraining.hee.nhs.uk/">http://specialtytraining.hee.nhs.uk/</a>. It is anticipated that completion of this three-year programme will allow you to complete the competences required for Core Training in Psychiatry and lead to eligibility to progress to the relevant Higher Psychiatry Training programme. Expected Rotation Information	<p>Core training in Psychiatry is of three years duration made up of six-month posts. For the first two years, everyone is rotated through General Adult Psychiatry in a limited geographical area with more complex posts in the second year. Then in the third year, trainees are expected to do some traveling away from their initial locality to broaden their educational experience and learn more specialised skills in developmental and other specific areas of psychiatry. It is important to note that trainees join the scheme, and not a particular post or Trust and therefore should be prepared to accept any post on the scheme.
