

<b>CT1 Psychiatry: West Midlands</b>	
<b>Programme Details</b>	<p>Core Psychiatry training in the West Midlands offers trainees a full range of teaching, learning and experience both clinical and non-clinical.</p> <p>Trainees are allocated to a cluster of CT1 level and are expected to remain within the cluster for the duration of their core training.</p> <p>The five geographic clusters within the region are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Birmingham</li> <li>• Black Country</li> <li>• Staffordshire &amp; Shropshire</li> <li>• Coventry &amp; Warwickshire</li> <li>• Worcestershire &amp; Herefordshire</li> </ul> <p>Each cluster is able to deliver a range of experience in psychiatry that is required for assessment and examination purposes.</p>

<b>Expected Rotation Information</b>	<p>All trainees will be in 6 month placements throughout core training. Their placements will be organised to meet their requirements as well as make sure the curriculum is covered. Posts will usually be general adult community mental health teams, in-patients/ home treatment teams, old age psychiatry at year 1 progressing to more specialist posts in child and adolescent mental health or Intellectual disability and Older adult at year 2 and then on to further sub-specialties such as neuropsychiatry, assertive outreach, early intervention, eating disorders, psychotherapy Liaison Psychiatry, Service for Hearing impairment and forensic at year 3. Trainees will likely stay within the same area throughout their rotation in core training. There are options for specialty training at CT3 level if there are local vacancy. Mandatory MRCpsych courses are available from two options (Birmingham Course &amp; Keel Course). Psychotherapy &amp; ECT competencies are organised locally by employing trust</p>
<b>Anticipated Duration</b>	3 years subject to satisfactory progression through ARCP
<b>Anticipated Outcome</b>	Completion of Core Psychiatry training
