Programme Details	<p>There are four Core Training schemes in the Yorkshire and the Humber School of Psychiatry (click here for further information). During the programme, trainees rotate through six month placements in a variety of specialties and are expected to pass the Membership Examination for the Royal College of Psychiatrists.</p> <p>Establishment of basic psychotherapy competencies is supported through a clear framework of training and supervision. Trainees are encouraged to participate themselves in the development and delivery of teaching and training and many continue into higher training within the Yorkshire area.</p>

Expected Rotation Information	Each trainee will rotate every six months within the rotation that they are offered a placement in. The specialties that they rotate within will depend on the trainee needs and the rotations availability. This will be discussed with the trainee before the first placement starts.
