What is the Medical Leadership Programme?

Academic Component

Successful candidates will be given the unique opportunity to undertake the NHS Leadership Academy's Elizabeth Garrett Anderson programme which will result in a MSc in Healthcare Leadership and a NHS Leadership Academy Award in Senior Healthcare Leadership.

The 2 year Medical Leadership Programme (MLP) is practically orientated and offers the opportunity to study alongside NHS Healthcare Managers.

The programme is delivered through a range of learning methods:

- Action Learning sets
- Face-to-face learning at workshops
- Online via a virtual campus

Clinical Component

The MLP is a flexible programme and is integrated into clinical training. In some cases to accommodate the MLP, clinical training could be extended up to a maximum of 12 months.

Vocational Component

This is designed to embed leadership theory in the clinical environment and comprises specific trainee-led work based projects and placements.
