MRI

Major trauma centre, inner city university department, sees in excess of 100,000 patients per year. Mainly urban population, lots of ethnic diversity, lots of students also. Co-located WIC run by GPs and nurse practitioners. Have our own observation ward run by ourselves and ANPs.

21 consultants, (4 ICU/ED, 4 ED/PEM, rest have mixture of responsibilities including trauma lead, college tutor, Foundation lead, Assoc post grad dean, CD, Assoc head of division, oh and 3 of them are Professors!)

As well as nursing team we have ENPs, ANPs (who rotate between MRI and Trafford UC centre), and also Physio practitioners in the department.

We are the home of Stemlyns, virtual hospital and online education platform, with off shoot StemyIns blog.

We are the birthplace and home of BestBETS, and EMERGING the centre for EM research led by Prof Rick Body.

We have weekly protected teaching for trainees, and a weekly journal club, and a monthly resus Friday departmental simulation session.

Forward thinking innovative department with motivated, hands on consultants who are clinically shop floor until midnight 7 days a week. We practice simulation, bedside USS, and RSIs. We are heavily involved in education, have Manchester University Med School students regularly, set up very successful SET programme to get trainees through CESAR programme, and Prof Mackway-Jones set up the MSc in Emergency Medicine.

Dedicated consultant shop floor presence until 11pm each day.

Have FY2 doctors, ST3 in EM, and ST7 in PEM and Paeds, as well as PEM and EM consultants.
