



Meeting the Standards for Educational Supervisors

The General Medical Council require that all of those who are engaged in training undergraduates or postgraduates are appropriately trained.

This two-day course will ensure that participants will be able to demonstrate compliance with the standards the GMC require for educational supervisors, and be able to apply, should they so wish, for Membership of the Academy of Medical Educators. Colleagues who have been trained and recognised as a clinical supervisor in the past couple of years need only attend “day 2” which will equip them for recognition as an educational supervisor

The two day programme is a condensed form of one of the postgraduate modules (MDS172, 20 credits) that we run as part of our provision of postgraduate education within the School of Medicine and we are applying for certification of this course as a 5 credit unit under the University of Liverpool’s postgraduate framework. Participants will be able to continue their studies, if they so wish to obtain a postgraduate certificate in Medical Education, or a Master of Science in Medicine, Surgery or Medical Education.

In preparation for the 2-day course, participants will need to complete a portfolio on-line, in which they will describe their current educational activity, and be encouraged to reflect upon how their current activity demonstrates that they meet the standards required by the GMC. During the course we will identify areas for further development, and help participants strengthen their portfolio.

You may register for this programme either on-line or through the Directorate of Education for your Trust, who will be informed of your successful completion of the course.

The cost of the 2 day course is £175, which covers access to the on-line facilities (including reading material), tuition, guidance and food and refreshments on each day. We expect that it will take about 2 hours to complete the first draft of your electronic portfolio, and you will need to do this before you attend the first day.
