The practice is a forward-looking practice and has 7 modern surgeries with 2 more additional surgeries planned. A comprehensive investment project for expansion, modernisation and refurbishment of the practice has now been completed. New facilities for patients and staff are now in place. These includes 3 additional surgeries, two new decontamination rooms (to the best practice standard), a new staff room with full facilities, staff changing room and a new office. All the other surgeries are updated. The practice is fully computerised throughout with the software of Excellence. All the surgeries are equipped with digital x-rays. The DF1 surgery is equipped with a new Belmont dental chair and modern air conditioning system. All the surgeries are fully equipped. Electro-surgery and rotary endodontic equipment is available in the surgeries. The practice is very busy and we provide a wide variety of dental treatment both NHS and private. The practice is located in North-East Manchester off Oldham Road inside the M60 motorway ring, approximately 3 miles from the city centre. The practice has been open for over twenty years, and now is a well-established family dental practice, offering NHS and private treatment. The socio-economic state of the area is very dynamic and diverse. The practice is a short walk from the main shopping street. It is also easily accessible from all parts of Manchester as well as having close proximity to the motorway network. The Dental team consists of the principal dentist, a Practice Business Supervisor (partner), several associate dentists who all stayed on at the practice after completing their DF1 year.
