This will include working alongside Specialists in both Paediatric Dentistry and Special Care Dentistry and several other very experienced Community Dentists.</p> <p>IASCD accredited training in inhalation sedation will be provided.</p> <p>The post also offers opportunities for in-hospital theatre experience for the provision of care under general anaesthetic on occasion.</p> <p>The service also hosts training posts for other postgraduate dentists in training – Dental Core Training and Specialty Training in Paediatric Dentistry and Special Care Dentistry.</p>
