St Marys Hospital is part of Manchester foundation Trust which now comprises St Marys Oxford Road, St Marys at Wythenshawe and North Manchester Hospital.

St Marys is a large tertiary unit with 10, 000 deliveries / year.

The rota is 2 tiers with 24 hours consultant cover. Each obstetric shift comprises of 2 SHOs, 2 registrars and a consultant as well as an additional triage Reg and an inpatient ward consultant for maternity. St Marys is a regional referral centre for complex maternal medicine cases, abnormal placenta lies, cardiac obstetrics and has a specialist fetal Medicine unit.

The Gynaecology services are spread across 2 sites. The Early pregnancy /emergency gynaecology unit is based at Wythenshawe. Benign gynaecology clinics at Withington community hospital. Urogynaecology and oncology services are based at Oxford road. Operating Theatres now run at St Marys and Trafford General

Whilst placement are primarily based at Oxford Road in order to gain sufficient experience and due to the provision of services across the MFT services – this job will comprise cross-site working.
