Standish is a village based near J27 of the M6, semi-rural but close to Wigan with easy access to Manchester, Liverpool and Preston. There are 5 surgeries and 6 dentists working there as well as a hygienist and a therapist. The building was converted in 2015 from a doctors' practice and all the chairs were fitted at that time. The staff are friendly and helpful, and there is an ethos of mutual support between all the dentists and staff.

Most of the patients have been coming to the same dentist for many years but we also have a healthy influx of new patients, some with complex and interesting problems.

Special interests include cosmetic dentistry like bonding, implants, orthodontics. Our sister practice has a specialist orthodontist based there but we are able to provide simpler treatments at Standish Standish Dental Practice is very busy in a mixed area with high patient's demands.
