

FRCR PART 1 MERSEY ANATOMY COURSE

Highlights of the Course:

- The mock examinations will be presented digitally, using **Apple Mac workstations**.
- The images will be viewed using **Osirix software**, which is identical to the software used by the Royal College of Radiologists, providing the opportunity to familiarize yourself prior to the RCR conducted exam.
- You will be provided with your **own workstation** during the course.
- **650** anatomy mock questions will be covered over the two days.
- **System based mocks (SBMs)** with feedback from expert radiology consultants.
- **SBMs topics include** – GIT, GU, O&G, Paediatric, Chest and Cardiac, MSK, Neuro, Vascular/Intervention, Head & Neck and Common Variants.
- In addition, there will be **three mock examinations**, simulating the exam setting which will be followed by feedback.
- Anatomy **workshops** with Q&A sessions.
- Discussion of hot topics, exam setting and previous questions.
